**PRAYER OF CONFESSION** (responsively) Psalm 51

One: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; in your great compassion blot out my offenses.

**All: Wash me through and through from my wickedness, and cleanse me from my sin.**

One: For I know my offenses, and my sin is ever before me.

**All: Against you only have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are justified when you speak and right in your judgment.**

One: Indeed, I was born steeped in wickedness, a sinner from my mother's womb.

**All: Indeed, you delight in truth deep within me, and would have me know wisdom deep within.**

One: Remove my sins with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be purer than snow.

**All: Let me hear joy and gladness that the body you have broken my rejoice.**

One: Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my wickedness.

**All: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.**

**All: Restore me to the joy of your salvation and sustain me with your bountiful Spirit.**

One: Let me teach your ways to offenders, and sinners shall be restored to you.

**All: Rescue me from bloodshed, O God of my salvation, and my tongue shall sing of your righteousness.**

One: O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth shall declare your praise.

**All: For you take no delight in sacrifice, or I would give it. You are not pleased with burnt offering. The sacrifice of God is a troubled spirit; a troubled and broken heart, O God, you will not despise.**

**LITANY OF PENITENCE** (responsively)

One: For our anger at our own frustration and our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves...

**All: Have mercy on us, O God.**

One: For our intemperate love of worldly goods and comforts, and our dishonesty in daily life and work...

**All: Have mercy on us, O God.**

One: For our negligence in prayer and worship, and our failure to commend the faith that is in us...

**All: Have mercy on us, O God.**

One: Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done. For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty...

**All: Have mercy on us, O God.**

One: For all false judgments, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors, and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us...

**All: Have mercy on us, O God.**

One: Restore us, O God of our salvation, and show us your steadfast love.

**All: Turn to us in your mercy and redeem us.**
